### **Bishop's Wood – Health & Safety Guidance Notes**

**Please enjoy your visit and observe the following conditions**

- Members and visitors are welcome to visit this woodland but are reminded that use of the car park and wood is entirely at their own risk.
- Woodland paths and bridges may be slippery and uneven.
- Some paths may be muddy after rain.
- The interior of the wood, away from footpaths, is retained as a natural habitat and exposes a risk of serious injury from damaged/fallen trees.
- The woods include a wide variety of fungi and plants that may cause serious illness if ingested.
- Guard against ticks and other biting insects.
- Permission to hold formal group activities in the wood or the education area should be sought through Elmwood College by writing to [strathkinnesscommunitytrust@gmail.com](mailto:strathkinnesscommunitytrust@gmail.com)
- Please clear up after your dog and dispose of waste and litter in the bin provided.
- Non-authorized lighting of fires is prohibited.
- Non-authorized sawing and removal of wood is prohibited.
- Camping and overnight use of the carpark is not permitted.
